### Provincial Fencing Coach – New Brunswick

Fencing-Esgrime NB is seeking an energetic, qualified fencing coach with a strong interest in and capability to develop annual and long term training and competition programs that result in a succession of NB fencers achieving success in national level competitions. The provincial coach is expected to work collaboratively with club coaches to improve the training and competition environment for all fencers in New Brunswick. The provincial coach must provide direct instruction on a daily basis at the provincial training centre for identified provincial fencers at the Train to Train and Train to Compete stages of development. This is a full-time 18 month contract position that, provided interim performance targets and standards are met, will evolve into a four-year contractual position with possibility for renewal.
